He spent the next five years of his life covering the social conflicts, natural disasters and daily life of the ravaged post civilwar central American countries.

In 2003 he moved to Toronto and started freelancing with The Globe and Mail, Canada's National Newspaper, where he became Staff Photographer in 2006.

His editorial clients include FASHION and CHATELAINE magazine, of which he is a regular contributor, as well as FQ, Canadian Art, Glow and Wish. His work has been exhibited at the Birch Libralato gallery and SHOWstudio.
